But many of our refugee children struggle to secure the necessary electronic gadgets to cope with their online schooling and home assignments. - As the epidemic situation stabilizes, our Employment Support Services On Tai Service Centre has resumed its usual consultation service every Thursday evening in May. - Give thanks! Our Centre for Refugees (CFR) has been reopened to its clients after months of closure to contain the virus spread.
